Planning Matters to include:

Planning application 143985 new water pipe line, Elsham to Lincoln

Document List (west-lindsey.gov.uk) – Members had perused the documents and discussed the distances for scoping, badger sett, noise impact, original source of water and vulnerability to drought and flood. Response sent to WLDC – "Page 117 of report states "majority of construction activity will be undertaken during the standard daytime working hours 0700 – 1900 hours Monday to Friday and 0700 – 1700 hours Saturday". In table 11-3 (page 120), the time period being measured for baseline noise levels is identical for the Monday to Friday period but only 0700 – 1300 hours for Saturday. Why is there a four-hour reduction in time frame when noise levels are being measured? In table 14-2 (Key scoping assumptions), under item 4. Working hours, it states "Currently expected to be weekdays 07:00- 19:00 and Saturday 07:00-16:00." Consistency in the definition of working hours for purposes of construction activity would be appreciated. In addition, a glossary of terms would be extremely useful when the planning application report is submitted."
